SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS - SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY

- 1. Any Firearm that is not concealed must be carried in a case or bag to and from the range. Firearms are to be uncased only in the shooting booth area.
- 2. Load and unload all weapons at the firing booth bench only.
- 3. Report any unsafe behavior or conditions to the Range Safety Officer immediately.
- 4. Be certain your gun is in good working order and know how to safely use it.
- 5. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded. Never pass the barrel over anything you do not wish to lose permanently.
- 6. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- 7. Know your target and what is beyond it.
- 8. Wear eve and ear protection before entering and while on the range.
- 9. Always keep firearms pointed down range. No one is allowed past the shooting stations or down range.
- 10. Do not pass firearms from shooter to shooter. Place the firearm on the booth bench and allow the next individual to pick the weapon up.
- 11. If you have a weapon malfunction lay your weapon on the booth bench and seek out the assistance of a Range Safety Officer.
- 12. Once arriving at your lane remain in that lane and shoot at only your target.
- 13. Never use alcohol or drugs before and/or during shooting.
- 14. Ammunition not allowed at G2G: steel-cored or penetrating type ammo, steel or aluminum cased ammo, tracer or incendiary ammo. Brass cased defensive ammo is allowed.
- 15. Use only appropriate ammo as directed by your gun manufacturer.
- 16. No drawing from your holster; firing from the ready position only
- 17. Shooters must be 21 or older. Under 20 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times and must sign 3rd party minor release waiver.
- 18. This facility is tobacco free usage of this substance in any form is not allowed.
- 19. Always remember to wash your hands after shooting and before eating.
- 20. No pistol calibers larger than .45 no rifle calibers larger than .223/5.56/AR-15
- 21. No pregnant women allowed in the shooting range for the safety of the woman and her unborn baby.
- 22. All expended brass casings become the property of G2G. Please do not pick up the brass casings once they are expended.
- 23. Immediately report all accidental discharges.

ANY VIOLATIONS OF THESE RULES CAN RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE RANGE AND LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP STATUS IF A MEMBER. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OF ANY KIND FOR PARTIES EXPELLED BECAUSE OF SAFETY VIOLATIONS.

SPECIAL NOTE: Children's Policies

Typically, children could possibly qualify as early as age 6, dependent on height. Parent would naturally have to be with them (in same station) and both have eye and ear protection. The child must be able to see over the shooting bench easily and cannot stand on anything or be held up to shoot. A Range Safety Officer will accompany first time shooters to determine these parameters and overall safety to approve the child to shoot. For the very young children we would prefer to see them shooting BB guns or Airsoft. G2G reserves the right to refuse any child participation where safety is an issue. Disqualified children may re-apply at a later date. Parent will be required to sign an additional waiver prior to child's participation.
